VD 2. 1st, FAY-Smith's Ch Winuwuk Scouting for Girls at Lorossa, BW, Good head with dark eye, well off for bone with substance & excellent musculation throughout correct front & rear angulation moved well BVIS. 2nd Beardsell & Van Beck & Fielding's BW, Newlaithe The Fugitive. 8 years old has not lost his good construction which he used to move well & cover the ground. Pleasing head & arched neck, level topline, strong quarters, shown in hard condition.

MPD. 4, 1st Pearce & Francis's Longsdale Stormin Norman, this boy caught my eye from the start, very stylish outline, good bone & tight feet, still immature in head as to be expected at 6 months with good rise of skull & dark eye, arched neck leading to level topline & correct tailset, good angulation front & rear will watch his progress with interest. Best Puppy Dog.

2ND Pearce & Francis's Longsdale Staying Put, another beautifully schooled quality puppy with a balanced outline, again yet to break in head, unlucky to have such a handsome litter mate. 3rd Keenan & Griffin's Duxara Double Diamond

PD. 1st Fay-Smith's Lorossa Relight My Fire, promising young boy head correct for age arched neck level topline well angulated quarters a square outline completes the picture. 2nd Godwin's Sultash Prince of Hearts, good clean head liked his expression, strong neck leading to level topline and correct tailset Correct front and rear just a tad longer in loin than one 3RD Lafferty's Greenawell Lorenzo

JD. 4 1st Brough & Cairns Galicar Ina Wrap with Limubox, I liked this boys head, well padded muzzle & dark eye arched neck leading to a short level back, good forechest & layback of shoulder & well angulated back end, very stylish. 2nd Beardsell & Van Beck's Newlaithe Super Natural, nice head with dark expressive eye short back, good angulation front & rear, moved well 2nd 3rd Mullis's Idleford Let's Do It

YD, 2. 1st Humphries Norwatch Sunhawk Good Time with Chribanna. This boy has a pleasing head good shaped dark eye, correct forechest & layback of shoulder, level topline & good rear angulation 2nd Hincliffe Kizzylee Big Bopper, a red ! nice head with a super mouth very wide & straight, ample angulation front & rear with a level topline and good tailset.

ND 4,1.1st Payne's Willow Storm Chaser, Well grown dog of substance, good head & dark eye, correct rise of skull & lip placement. Flows from arched neck into a level topline & good tailset, correct angulation front & back, well off for bone. 2nd Mair's Glenauld Arthur Shelby, nice head and rise of skull good bone and tight feet, evident forechest and good turn of stifle, lovely outline. 3rd Williams Henry Lucky.

GD 8,2. 1st Cherry's Cherryforge Galileo. very stylish boy of good size and substance, lovely balanced head with dark eye & good mouth, arched neck well used, well developed forehead with evident forechest & correctly laid shoulder, firm topline, correctly angulated quarters with short hocks, moved with drive RCC Im sure he will make the upper house. 2nd Beardsell Van Beck & Fielding's Newlaithe Suited n Booted with Lefargo, another stylish boy, well handled, lovely expression, arched neck which he used well, straight topline & good tailset, good anulation in front rear angulation not quite as good as 1, pleasing picture overall. 3rd Cook & Postance Manic Thinking Out Loud

PGD 8,2. 1st Mair's Glenauld Stormzy. Good head with well padded muzzle & good mouth arched neck leading to well muscled body, short back & good angulation both front & rear which he used to motor round the ring. 2nd Godwin's Sultash Cunco, slightly longer in frame than 1 but a very stylish

boy correct head with dark eye & super chin, well constructed body good neck level topline evident
forechest and good shoulders correct angulation to rear. 3rd Loadsby's Berwynfa Fifty Shades Freed
LD10,3. 1ST Brown & Hutching's Winuwuk In the Name Of Lust A1, clean head with dark eyes lovely
expression & good mouth, upstanding male with good bone & tight feet, arched neck flowing into
well laid shoulder and forechest, good topline kept his outline on move 2ND Jones & Charles's
Charlons Perseus, typical & balanced head, arched neck short level topline correct tailset, well
muscled body with good bone & tight feet, well angulated front & rear, moved well. 3rd Beardsell &
Van Beck's Newliathe Diddle On

OD 4,2. 1st Griffith 'S Ch Lanfrese Argento, what a stunning male this is, lovely balanced head lean
skull and full muzzle, dark expressive eye & wide mouth, well arched neck flows into super shoulder
placement & forechest, straight front well boned with tight feet sloping topline & bang on tailset
sweeping hard muscled quarters with good thigh and short in hock, shown in well toned condition,
and moved effortless round the ring. CC, and with my co judges agreement, BIS. 2nd Brough &
Cairns's Ch Galicar Investigating with Limubox I liked this one as a youngster, pleasing head with
dark eye & good mouth, arched neck & level topline with good tailset, correct shoulder with evident
forechest good shoulders and correctly muscled rear, moved well
