

The Mancunian Boxer Club Championship Show

Judge: Vicky Bell - Surfstone

I would like to thank the Mancunian Boxer Club for the invitation to judge their very well-run show and also the exhibitors for such a fabulous entry in both quality and quantity. A few worrying observations were some exhibits with rear movement that has a cycling action, short upper arms are still common and overdone heads seem to be more of a problem in bitches rather than dogs. That a side movement away and back has improved massively, rear angulation has really improved with very few that were over angulated plus shape and topline on the move have got much better.

VETERAN DOG (5,0)

- 1) Brough & Cairns, Ch Galicar Investigating with Limubox JW 7 yrs, good size B/W with an eye catching outline, standing firm and proud on well boned legs and correct feet, balanced head, good stop, large nostrils and well-padded muzzle, dark eye and correct ear set, excellent mouth that's wide and tight, would prefer better chin and lip placement, crested neck, level topline and high tailset, hammy quarters with good turn of stifle, evident forechest, good lay and length of shoulder but short in upper arm, strong loin and good underline, moved straight away and back, side action is free flowing and powerful, moving fluently with his handler. - 2) Louis, Rameleon Nights in Harlem nearly 11 yrs DB/W, such an honest dog with correct square proportions, correct bone and substance for size with excellent feet, clean head with good proportions, dark eye and correct earset, good lip placement with excellent mouth, long crested neck, evident withers and strong topline, corresponding front and rear angles, short strong hocks, moved straight away and back with easy side action covering the ground with purpose and drive, a real credit to his owner.

MINOR PUPPY DOG (4,0)

- 1) Huggins, Boxania Rock and Roll Star for Daervlish, 8 months, DB/W good size with corresponding bone and substance for age with lovely round strong feet, his outline presents an overall square and balanced picture, super head still raw just as it should be at this stage with correct proportions, clean with good rise of skull and stop, square muzzle with good lip placement, mouth and chin, wide nose and nostrils, kind expression, clean arched neck, evident withers, short strong topline, correct croup and tailset, neat straight front, corresponding front and rear angles, short hocks and strong pasterns, moved straight away and back, moved steadily around the ring covering the ground well with a positive free action.

- 2) Chell, Jimbren Elite Legacy at Ludic just under 9 months, B/W taller and rangier than one presenting a more elegant outline with adequate bone and substance at this age, super immature head with dark correct eye shape and placement giving a quizzical expression, good stop and large nose and nostrils, mouth ok, good length of neck, evident withers into short firm topline, correct croup and tailset, good turn of stifle, nicely developing forechest, moved close away and back, fluent side action covering the ground with ease, just preferred the overall balance of 1.

PUPPY DOG (5,1)

- 1) Farvalley Major Luke at Susancar, 10 months RB/W, well grown and rangy with ample bone and substance, presenting superb framework to grow into, stood on super catlike feet, super head that is clean with correct proportions, tight dark kind eye, good width and depth of muzzle, super chin and correct mouth and dentition, long, clean arched neck into evident withers, short slightly sloping topline and bang on tailset, evident forechest with good lay of shoulder and upper arm, well ribbed with strong loin and correct underline, short strong hocks and well-muscled quarters with the correct turn of stifle that powered him round the ring with ease, moved straight away and back and his side action was elastic, free and ground covering, superb temperament and just wanted to please his able handler, I am sure he will have a very bright future, BPD.
- 2) Marbelton I Dare You for Bugarivo nearly 12 months R/W, there's a lot to like about this raw puppy, strongly built with correct bone and substance, presents a super clean, well balanced outline, clean head with correct muzzle to skull ratio, good stop and rise of skull, good lip placement, chin and mouth, superb expressive dark eye, loved his expression, strong, clean neck into short firm top line and correct tailset, superb shoulder placement and length of upper arm, good width and depth of brisket with evident forechest, correct underline, strong hammy quarters with correct turn of stifle and short strong hocks, moved straight away and back, he has powerful, ground covering movement, moving with style, purpose and evident forward reach, superb temperament.

JUNIOR DOG (2,0)

- 1) Brough, Limubox Scotch Gold, 13 month R/W mature for age, super square outline, in fit condition with super muscle tone, plenty of bone and substance with excellent feet, correctly proportioned head but would like less wrinkle, expressive dark eye, good stop and lovely width and depth to his muzzle, good mouth, evident chin with good lip placement, good reach of neck into strong short topline, evident forechest with good lay back of shoulder and good length of upper arm, hammy quarters with well let down hocks, straight moving away and back, powerful side action with good forward reach and rear drive.

- 2) Robinson, Arkeney Fusion, 17 month super deer R/W taller than 1, racy looking at this stage of his growth and needs to fill into his large frame with excellent bone and substance, well-muscled throughout, clean head that still has development with good ear placement, dark tight eye and correct stop, large nose and wide nostrils, clean arched neck, slightly sloping topline and good tailset, evident forechest, good depth of chest and spring of rib, close away and back, unsettled as he moved around the ring, just needs time to mature.

YEARLING DOG (1,0)

- 1) Mair, Sulez Striker at Glenauld, 20 months rich B/W substantial full bodied appearance with excellent bone, substance and catlike feet, strong head with well set ears and dark eye, thickly padded square muzzle, wide nose and large nostrils and excellent straight mouth, strong neck into evident withers, level topline and high tailset, super quarters with good turn of stifle and short hocks, good forechest and spring of rib, correct curving underline, straight moving away and back covering the ground well as he powered around the ring, in excellent muscular condition.

NOVICE DOG (5,1)

- 1) Bee, Beeann Big Story, nearly 2 year old red B/W small and compact with a super square outline, correct bone and substance for his size with excellent feet, heavy in head and short in foreface, super dark eye and well padded square muzzle, crested neck, short strong sloping topline, straight front with good length and depth of rib, corresponding front and rear angulation, strong hammy quarters with well let down hocks, straight moving away and back, precise side action covering the ground with ease whilst keeping his outline.
- 2) Thomson, Arkeney Desperado Von Bugarivo Al, nearly 2 ½ years dark B/W top size substantial square dog with bone and substance to match, clean well-proportioned head with dark expressive eye and well set ears, flat cheeks, large nose and nostrils, would prefer more turnup of nose, excellent wide mouth, evident withers, good topline and tailset, excellent front and rear angulation, with strong quarters, evident forechest and width of brisket, movement straight away and back, good length of stride once he settled going round.

GRADUATE DOG (4,0)

- 1) Kavanagh, Marbelton In The Mix 2 ½ years, mahogany B/W, wow this dog is all male without exaggeration or overdone muscle, he is upstanding and square with a clean flowing outline and has a look at me Boxer temperament, he has that all important balance of substance and elegance, standing firm on super cat like feet, masculine clean head, correct proportions with flat cheeks, good stop and rise of skull, broad nose and large nostrils, good width and depth of muzzle, excellent mouth and dentition with evident chin and correct lip placement, well set ears with dark correctly shaped eyes giving a fabulous expression, swan like clean neck flowing into evident withers with a strong, broad, slightly sloping topline, and bang on tailset,

excellent forechest width and depth, with correct flat shoulders, excellent lay back of shoulder and length of upper arm, correct lay of pastern, correct length of leg to depth of chest and super tuck up, well ribbed back and strong through the loin, superb quarters with correct width of upper and lower thigh, strong short hocks used correctly on the move, moved straight away and back, he covers a lot of ground with very little effort, having excellent forward reach and hind thrust, keeping his beautiful outline at all times and his topline is firm and unwavering, an impressive male that screams Boxer, pleased to award him his first CC & BIS

- 2) Robinson, Ulverbox Magic and Mayhem, 3 year old B/W overall smaller and cobbier build than 1 but with correct bone and substance for his size and super feet, presented a lovely square outline on strong limbs, strong in head with a dark eye and well set ears, large nostrils and wide mouth, would prefer better lip placement and chin, crested neck into good withers and short strong topline, excellent front assembly with corresponding rear angles, strong hammy quarters that he used well on the move, covering the ground with ease whilst being at one with his handler.

POST GRAD DOG (4,1)

- 1) Van-Beck, Newlaithe Respect JW, 2 ½ year old red B/W, tall with a striking square outline and plenty of ring presence, well-muscled throughout with strong bone and substance, super feet, clean head of correct proportions with good rise of skull, correct dark eye, wide nostrils and good lip placement, strong arched neck into well-defined withers, strong slightly sloping topline and bang on tailset, excellent shoulder placement and evident forechest, strong quarters with good turn of stifle and short, well let down hocks, powerful movement with excellent forward reach and good hindthrust, covering a lot of ground with ease.
- 2) Mair, Glenauld The Chase, 22 month old, tall and robust presenting a compact outline with a striking deer red jacket, plenty of bone and substance, heavier in head than 1 with well set ears, correct lip to lip placement and good chin, crested neck set on a good forehead with correct width and depth of brisket and well sprung ribs, short, strong topline and good tailset, short loin and correct underline, well-muscled quarters contributing to strong rear movement, covering plenty of ground and keeping his outline at all times.

LIMIT DOG (9,0)

- 1) Woods, Arkeney Conqueror, 4 year old Mahogany B/W, tall and elegant with a crisp outline, correct bone and substance for his build with super feet, head of correct proportions and very clean with excellent width and depth of muzzle and wide nostrils, excellent wide mouth with correct chin and lip to lip placement, lovely dark expressive eyes, long arched neck into correct withers to a strong topline and bang on tailset, correct front assembly with evident forechest, clean underline, well developed quarters with enough angulation and short strong hocks, moved straight

away and back with a far reaching side action covering a lot of ground with correct driving rear action, keeping his super outline at all times.

- 2) Fox, Britesparke Norman Moon, 5 year old red B/W, top size, robust and honest with super bone and substance, standing firm on superb catlike feet, clean masculine head with correct ratio of muzzle to skull, blocky muzzle with large nose and nostrils, good rise of skull and well set ears, dark eyes completing a lovely expression, super crested neck, firm slightly sloping topline and super tailset, good layback of shoulder with correct width and depth of brisket, well ribbed with good tuck up, excellent hammy quarters with well let down hocks, moved straight away and back, powerful on the move and at one with his handler, just preferred the shape of 1 on the move.

OPEN DOG (10,0)

- 1) Jones & Charles, Charlons Perseus nearly 7 year old mahogany B/W, a medium sized dog who is so he well put together and correctly muscled throughout with correct body proportions and a striking outline, a dog I have admired on a few occasions and getting my hands on him didn't disappoint, correct bone and substance for his stature with excellent well-padded catlike feet, super head, masculine without excess wrinkle, square blocky muzzle with good sweep of underjaw, wide straight mouth, gorgeous dark expressive eyes giving that true Boxer expression, strong crested neck into evident withers flowing to a short firm topline and bang on tailset, super forehand with correct front angulation and corresponding rear angles, evident forechest and clean shoulders, strong well let down hocks that drove him around the ring with power and ease, moved straight away and back with a super side gait which is far reaching and free flowing whilst keeping his super square outline, a credit to his owner, pleased to award him the RCC & RBIS, just pipped at the post by the graduate winner for the CC, I just preferred his combination of size and elegance on the day.
- 2) Mair, Ch Macbarra Kicken Up A Storm at Glenauld JW just over 3 years old red B/W, top size dog that I have admired from the ringside on many, many occasions, very honest, unexaggerated and robust, ample bone and substance and stands proudly on super round tight feet, slightly heavier in head than 1, correct muzzle to skull proportions with good turnup of nose and sweep of under jaw, good width and depth of muzzle with excellent mouth, good stop and rise of skull, super eye shape and colour giving a lovely expression, arched neck into a broad firm, slightly sloping topline and correct tailset, adequate front angulation, good spring of rib and strong short loin with super tuck up, broad well-muscled quarters, with correct turn of stifle and short well let down hocks, moved straight away and back with a powerful, ground coving side action, moving freely and at one with his handler at all times, just preferred the better forehand of 1

VETERAN BITCH (5,3)

- 1) McDonald Ch Yeteb Little Miss Muffet JW 8 year old B/W substantial build with super square outline, well off for bone and substance standing on excellent tight catlike feet, super head of correct proportions with well set ears and lovely expressive eyes, set correctly, well padded square muzzle with good width of under jaw and excellent mouth, wide nose and large nostrils, arched neck leading to strong, slightly sloping topline and correct tailset, good front assembly with evident forechest, clean shoulders and good depth of rib and correct tuck up, hammy quarters with correct turn of stifle and short strong hocks, moved straight away and back with a free flowing side action covering the ground with ease and purpose.
- 2) Van-Beck Newlaithe Pureoco JW 7 year old red B/W smaller build all round that 1 with correct bone and substance for her size with super feet, neat compact outline, not as clean in head as 1 but has correct muzzle to skull ratios, excellent mouth and lip placement, large nose and wide nostrils, good stop and rise of skull, correct dark eye, elegant arched neck flowing into a firm slightly sloping topline and high tailset, corresponding front and rear angles with clean shoulders and sweeping underline, strong well-muscled quarters with well let down hocks, moved out well with drive and reach, moved straight away and back.

BABY PUPPY BITCH (1,0)

- 1) Pynegar Berwynfa Dolly Wally Doodle 5 month mahogany B/W, promising puppy with stylish outline, pretty head with good stop and rise of skull, neat well padded muzzle with evident chin and correct sweep of underjaw, excellent eye shape that is dark and expressive, arched neck into straight slightly sloping topline and good tailset good forehand assembly with evident forechest, good depth of rib but would prefer a shorter loin, good quarters with super width of thigh and correct turn of stifle, short strong hocks, moved steadily around the ring with a happy temperament. MINOR PUPPY BITCH (6,0)

- 1) Flintoft Boxania Ebony Eyes, 8 months dark brindle, still very much a baby compared to the rest of the class but so well constructed with square outline and balanced throughout with no exaggeration, correct bone and substance for her age and size, clean head of correct proportions, lovely black velvet muzzle of correct width and depth with evident chin and lip to lip placement, bold expressive dark eye producing a beautiful expression, long crested neck into short slightly sloping topline and correct tailset, good lay of shoulder and length of upper arm, good depth of brisket, nicely developing quarters with correct width and depth of upper and lower thigh and strong hocks, moved straight away and back with a free elastic side action, covering plenty of ground with excellent forward reach keeping her lovely outline and at one with her handler.
- 2) Parker & Martin Olleyville Juliett, 9 month old dark B/W, well grown with a striking outline, not as square as 1, with excellent bone, substance and feet, good head proportions with good stop and rise of skull, dark eye and well set ears, blocky

muzzle with large nose and nostrils, wide under jaw with good mouth and super pigmentation, long crested neck into evident withers and level topline to high tailset, evident forechest with good width and depth of rib with elegant underline, adequate front angulation with strong pasterns, super quarters, well-muscled with good turn of stifle and short straight hocks, moved straight away and back with powerful driving movement keeping her outline as she drove around the ring, just preferred front assembly of 1.

PUPPY BITCH (8,1)

- 1) McDonald, Yeteb Little Miss Splendid, 10 month old dark B/W and wow is she Splendid, she is feminine and oozes quality with superb construction and body proportions throughout, super square, clean outline that flows from head to toe, correct bone and substance for her size and super tight catlike feet, clean brick shaped head of correct proportions, correct stop, rise of skull and well placed ears, muzzle is broad and deep with tight flews, excellent mouth and under jaw, lip to lip placement and super turnup of nose, tight, dark almond eyes giving a mischievous, melting expression, swan like neck with plenty of reach, well defined withers and short, firm, slightly sloping topline into correct tailset, forehand is top class with her elbows well under her front showing correct front angulation, evident breast bone, excellent width and depth of brisket with clean shoulders, correct rib cage and underline with short strong loin, super hammy quarters with excellent turn of stifle and well let down short strong hocks, she was one of the best movers on the day, moving straight away and back and driving out as she moved round, covering the ground fluently and effortlessly with superb forward reach and correct hock action and keeping her fabulous shape as she went, pushed hard in the challenge and delighted to award her the RCC, BPB & BPIS
- 2) Wood, Arkeney Geneva, 11 month old B/W top size and rangier in type than 1 just needs time to fill into her frame, short coupled with ample bone and substance, lovely clean head with correct proportions of muzzle to skull, super tight dark almond eye, good mouth, underjaw and lip placement, large nose with wide nostrils, good length of neck into evident withers and short, slightly sloping topline, bang on tailset, clean shoulders with evident forechest, good lay of shoulder but a little short in upper arm, well sprung ribs with good depth and short strong loin, well developed hammy quarters with good turn of stifle and strong hocks, moved straight away and back with a fluent side action with plenty of drive from the rear.

- 1) McCarthy & Gething, Lorrosa My Heads Been Turned to Jeddhi, 14 month old of square medium build with excellent outline and ring presence, bone, substance and

feet all correct for her size and age, lovely clean head with flat cheeks, correct stop, rise of skull and neat well placed ears, good muzzle proportions with excellent mouth, chin and lip placement, gorgeous eye giving super boxer expression, crested neck onto evident withers, strong level topline and correct tailset, correct corresponding front and rear angulation, straight front with correct height to leg ratios, super tuck up, well-muscled quarters with super width and depth of upper thigh, strong well let down hocks, straight moving away and back with stylish side action covering plenty of ground with ease.

- 2) Van-Beck & Taylor, Crime Squad Newlaithe, 12 month old another with a stunning crisp outline, square and petite in stature as only just out of puppy, correct bone and substance for her size and age, super brick shaped, clean head with dark pigment, nicely developing muzzle, wide nose and nostrils, good stop and rise of skull with lovely expression from excellent shaped dark eye, lovely length of neck into evident withers and firm slightly sloping topline to a well set on tail, excellent front assembly with straight legs set well under and excellent forechest, well sprung ribs of good depth and elegant underline, short strong loin into correctly set on strong quarters with correct turn of stifle and short, firm hocks, moved straight away and back with strong, fluent side action, 2 very nice bitches.

YEARLING BITCH (4,1)

- 1) McCarthy & Gething, Jeddhi Ring Of Fire, 2 year old dark B/W medium sized super square body set on firm strong limbs giving a sharp flowing outline, clean head with lovely expressive, dark eye and well set ears, short blocky muzzle with plenty of padding, mouth ok and correct chin and lip to lip placement, cheeky expression, strong crested neck into short broad back with slightly sloping topline and bang on tailset, excellent front assembly with correct width and depth of brisket plus evident forechest, good depth of rib and tuck up, excellent width and depth of first and second thigh with perfect sweep of stifle into short well let down hocks, nicely muscled throughout, moved straight away and back, powerful movement with super forward reach and rear drive, well-handled and presented.
- 2) Drinkwater, Sulez Smashedit, 19 month old B/W taller more substantial bitch than 1, rangy in stature still needing to fill into her frame, but keeping the balance of substance with elegance, ample bone and substance with correct tight feet, appealing head of correct muzzle to skull ratios, not as clean as 1, super expressive dark eye of correct shape, good muzzle width and depth with good mouth and underjaw, long clean, arched neck into evident withers, level topline and high tailset, clean front set on strong straight legs, adequate front angulation, good spring of rib, well developed upper thigh with correct turn of stifle, moved straight away and back with a steady side gate covering plenty of ground with ease.

NOVICE BITCH (6,2)

- 1) Brough, Limubox Mango Tango, 13 month old R/W bitch substantial and strong, square in outline with plenty of bone and substance standing on well-padded round feet, clean head of good proportions with super expression from dark correctly shaped well set eyes, dark mask, square muzzle with good sweep and width of under jaw and tilt of nose, long crested neck, evident withers and short strong topline and correct tailset, corresponding front and rear angles, straight front with evident forechest, well ribbed and short strong loin, well-muscled throughout with hammy quarters, moved straight away and back with powerful movement, covering plenty of ground, well handled to her advantage.
- 2) Wood, Arkeney Enigma 2 year old B/W, tall with a sharp outline and slightly longer cast than 1, ample bone and substance, clean head with dark, correct eye shape and good pigment, well set ears, good lip placement and evident chin with a good mouth, clean long arched neck into strong broad topline and good tailset, corresponding front and rear angles, with front legs set well under her front, evident forechest, correct width and depth of rib with elegant underline, moved straight away and back with a free and easy ground covering side action, super temperament and wanting to please her handler.

GRADUATE BITCH (6,0)

- 1) Payne, Birleyvale Burning Heart, 2 ½ year old B/W a very honest medium sized bitch, square in body with good proportions presenting an elegant outline, enough bone and substance with super feet, lovely clean brick shaped head of correct muzzle to skull ratios with good stop and rise of skull, dark correct eye and neatly set ears, balanced muzzle with good lip placement and under jaw, kind expression, clean crested neck into straight, slightly sloping topline and bang on nailset, corresponding front and rear angles, straight front with evident forechest, neat underline and well ribbed into taught loin, correct pasterns and short hocks, moved straight away and back, side movement was fluid and free flowing, well handled.
- 2) Van-Beck, Diddle On Newlaithe, 2 ½ year old B/W cobby and robust in build with a sharp eye-catching outline, good bone, substance and tight catlike feet, clean head with super expression, shorter in foreface than 1, correct stop and good rise of skull, well placed neat ears, blocky muzzle without excess flew, good mouth and correct shaped dark eye, strong arched neck into evident withers, short, firm topline and high tailset, evident forechest, good lay back of shoulder, super spring of rib, short strong loin and elegant tuck up, super quarters with width and depth, short well let down hocks, moved straight away and back with energetic side action but not covering as much ground as 1, well handled.

POST GRAD BITCH (5,1)

- 1) Turner, Kevanor African Summer at Sonshoby, 3 year old good size dark B/W with a striking outline, standing square and firm on good legs and feet, well off for bone and substance whilst retaining elegance, quality head with good stop and super rise of skull, neat ears, gorgeous dark expressive eye, short square well-padded muzzle, and evident chin, correct turnup of nose and melting expression, crested neck into straight, slightly sloping topline to bang on tailset, straight front with evident forechest, corresponding front and rear angulation, well ribbed back and sweeping underline, well-muscled quarters with good turn of stifle and well let down firm hocks, moved straight away and back with super free flowing side action with evident reach and drive.
- 2) Huggins, Willow Belle Star for Daervlish lkc, 2 year old B/W, slightly smaller and more compact in body shape with a super sharp outline, so well put together and flowed throughout, head of correct muzzle to skull ratios but not as clean as 1, evident stop and rise of skull, dark eye, large nose and wide nostrils, good mouth, long arched neck used to advantage, evident withers, firm, sloping topline into high tailset, super front angulation with good forechest and depth of brisket, good spring and depth of rib, evident tuck up and short strong loin, hammy quarters with lovely sweep of stifle to short strong hocks, moved straight away and back, unfortunately she was not quite happy on the move today, 2 very nice bitches, just preferred the movement of 1 on the day.
